The Free Clinic Board Votes to Gift Assets to The Community Foundation of Harrisonburg and Rockingham County *Gift will continue to help meet healthcare needs in the community*



The Community Foundation would like to share the following information from the Harrisonburg-Rockingham Free Clinic:

The Free Clinic Board of Directors has voted to gift all of the Free Clinic's physical and cash assets to The Community Foundation of Harrisonburg and Rockingham County to help fund affordable, accessible healthcare in the community.

The Free Clinic ceased operations in December 2020 due to a number of factors, including changes in patient base, volunteer provider availability, and funding needs.

The Free Clinic's assets also include the three-story, 13,566-square-foot building on Water Street where it operated. "The Community Foundation has completed its due diligence on accepting this gift," said Revlan Hill, Executive Director of The Community Foundation. "We look forward to accepting the property. Our work will then turn to the future of the building. This would include exploring donating the property to an organization serving the healthcare needs of our community."

Revlan said a task force has been formed to work on the disposition of the property. She noted that if the committee is not able to identify a feasible recipient for the property, The Community Foundation will sell

it, and the net proceeds will be added to a healthcare endowment at the Foundation to address unmet healthcare needs in the Harrisonburg and Rockingham communities.
